Harvest the central head first and watch for many smaller heads to follow from the side shoots.



Raab Zamboni Davs to harvest: 70

Our Italian broccoli (Spring Rapini) has green shoots and tasty, mustardlike leaves with a captivating flavor. It's a favorite choice for Italian and Chinese cooking. You'll love it lightly sautéed with garlic and olive oil, fresh in salads and cooked in soups. Cut 6-in. (15-cm) pieces when the "broccolis" are the size of a quarter. Raab Zamboni is a great source of vitamins A, C and K, as well as potassium.



BRUSSELS SPROUTS

Franklin

Days to harvest: 80

These small, 1-in. (2-cm) sprouts look like miniature heads of cabbage, and are tasty when steamed just to the point of tenderness or enjoyed raw. Gardeners should note that their flavor is improved by a few light frosts. Grow Franklin as a Fall crop in the North and as a Fall and Winter crop in frostfree areas. The tall plants have less woody stalks than other varieties, so whole stem harvest is possible.

Always sweet...always mild! A gardener favorite for 35 years, All-America Selections Winner Snow Crown is one of the easiest cauliflowers to grow. thanks to its quick growth and strong vigor. The plants produce big yields



of fully domed, white heads up to 8 in. (20 cm) across, weighing 1 to 2 lbs. (454 to 908 g). Extremely nutritious, versatile Snow Crown may be eaten raw, cooked, pickled or frozen. You don't need to hurry to harvest the heads, as Snow Crown holds its eating quality for up to 10 days in the garden. Boxwood Basil



Sweet Mammoth Basil

Height: 18 to 24 in. (45 to 60 cm)

This lettuce-leaf variety from Italy grows ruffled leaves as large as your hand, delivering a very strong flavor that's perfect for sauces, pesto and even fresh on a sandwich. Try growing this basil on a sunny windowsill - it loves filtered light. Removing flowers from basil encourages maximum growth and the best leaf production.



Santo Cilantro

Height: 12 to 24 in. (30 to 60 cm)

One of the most popular fresh herbs, this cilantro is fast growing and slow to bolt, so you can harvest later into the season. Its unmistakable sharp scent and taste have made it the staple herb in salsa and other Mexican dishes. The leaves can be cut at any time, using the upper, new, finely cut leaves in cooking. Cilantro is not normally saved and dried like other culinary herbs since it loses almost its entire flavor when dried.



Fernleaf Dill

Height: 12 to 15 in. (30 to 38 cm)

The perfect patio container dill! Unlike taller, "floppy" varieties, these dwarf, compact plants do not need staking and won't topple over. Add in later flowering and lush, dark green leaves, and you've got plants that look great all season long. Fernleaf makes a terrific seasoning with fish and vegetable dishes - you can use it fresh, frozen and dried to enjoy the taste all year long. If you're growing cabbage, onions or lettuce, be sure to plant Fernleaf, too - it's a great companion plant!



Dill

Height: 36 in. (90 cm)

Dill originates in Eastern Europe, but is a great addition to herb gardens or patio containers (deeper than 10 in./25 cm) in almost any climate. To encourage seed production, allow the flowers to form and go to seed. For fresh dill, remove the leaves just as the herb flowers.

Marjoram is sweeter and spicier than oregano but used in much the same way. This herb is great combined with garlic, onion, thyme or basil and you can even harvest the flowers for salads. Used fresh or dried, its leaves are perfect for salads, dressings, lamb dishes and soups. You can begin lightly harvesting as soon as 6 weeks from planting.



Italian Dark Single **Parsley**

Height: 15 to 18 in. (38 to 45 cm)

This herb's flat, deeply cut dark green leaves are very flavorful and attractive in any herb garden. It can be used for flavoring meat, soups and salads but is most widely used as a garnish. It grows well in sun or part shade, and adds texture to mixed containers.





This parsley's wonderful flavor and its excellent source of vitamins and minerals make it an herb garden favorite. Triple Curled is fast-growing and produces closely curled dark leaves. When mature, it holds for a long time, making harvesting easy. Use as a flavoring or garnish.

Sweet Leaf Stevia

Height: 18 to 30 in. (45 to 75 cm)

The food and beverage industry is abuzz with news of this safe alternative to artificial sweeteners - now home gardeners can produce their own! The incredibly sweet leaves of this South American native are an herbal alternative to sugar and are up to 30 times sweeter. Each bushy, highyielding plant yields up to 0.5 lb. (227 g) of dried leaves. Also useful fresh.







Summer Savorv

Height: 12 to 20 in. (30 to 50 cm)

The peppery-tasting leaves keep coming as fast as you can pick them from the prolific plants! Terrific used fresh or dried to season beans, meats and stuffing, and a great salt substitute, Summer Savory is one of the essential ingredients in Herbs de Provence (along with rosemary, thyme and oregano). Whorls of light purple flowers add a touch of color to the green-leafed plants in the Summer.



PERENNIAL HERBS

Catnip

Height: 36 in. (90 cm)

USDA Hardiness Zones: 3 to 9

We all know cats love catnip, so why not grow some in your garden and harvest it to dry and fill your kitty's toys as a special treat? Catnip is a type of mint that grows into an attractive plant, with bluish flowers in mid-Summer. You can begin harvesting catnip when it's about 12 in. (30 cm) tall and continue all season.



PERENNIAL HERBS (CONTINUED)

Garlic Chives

Height: 24 to 30 in. (60 to 75 cm) **USDA Hardiness Zones:** 3 to 10

This popular and attractive Asian herb has garlic-flavored leaves that can be enjoyed fresh or dried. The stems aren't hollow and are skinnier and flatter than traditional chives. The plants will tolerate light shade, but try for full sun and be sure to harvest the stem almost all the way to the ground to ensure this herb produces new stems.

Onion Chives

Height: 12 to 18 in. (30 to 45 cm) **USDA Hardiness Zones:** 3 to 10

Chives make an attractive edging for any flower or vegetable garden and are a versatile kitchen herb that's excellent for seasoning a wide array of recipes. Chives grow well in gardens or patio containers with tall, green, grasslike leaves ending in purple pom-pom flowers. Harvest continuously from early Summer until frost.





Ellagance Purple Lavender

Height: 12 in. (30 cm)

USDA Hardiness Zones: 6 to 9

Great as a garden plant and for drying and arranging, first-yearflowering Ellagance Purple has rich green foliage and large, elegant flowers that bloom all Summer and attract butterflies. It makes a fragrant addition to flower arrangements with dense, upright flowers on sturdy stems.



Height: 36 in. (90 cm) USDA Hardiness Zones: 5 to 10

Oregano

This versatile culinary herb is widely used, most often dried, in Italian dishes, tomato sauce, pizza, fish and salad dressing. Oregano requires little maintenance and makes an excellent edging plant or ground covering, even in dry garden spots.



Greek Oregano

Height: 14 to 24 in. (35 to 60 cm) **USDA Hardiness Zones:** 5 to 9

This is the herb that is synonymous with pizza and tomato sauce, as well as Italian dishes, fish and salad dressings. The wild spice of ancient Greece, Greek oregano was originally grown only for medicinal use, but today's gardeners harvest the dark green leaves for their warm and spicy flavor that is stronger than regular oregano. The bushy plants are topped by white flowers in Summer.

Peppermint

Height: 4 to 6 in. (10 to 15 cm)

USDA Hardiness Zones: 3 to 10

Peppermint is easy to grow and spreads quickly, so try it in a patio container or even a container "planted" in the garden. With its square purple stems and purplish leaves, Peppermint makes a unique ornamental plant. It's best as a dried herb with vegetables, as a garnish, in sauces and combined with other herbs to make tea. This wonderfully aromatic mint also makes great potpourri.





Sage is one of the best garden herbs because when protected, it will grow into a sturdy perennial shrub in most climates. The leaves are best when harvested before or just after blooming. Use fresh or dried with poultry, sausages, meats and vegetables.



Summer Thyme

Height: 12 to 18 in. (30 to 45 cm) USDA Hardiness Zones: 6 to 10

Thyme is easy to grow, shows attractive foliage and is one of the most useful herbs in the kitchen. This is a handsome, low-growing plant with aromatic leaves used to flavor meats, poultry, stews, sauces, soups and dressings. Harvest mid-June through mid-July. Leaves are used fresh or dried. Thyme is excellent in patio containers and is virtually free of pests and disease.

Rosemary

Height: 24 in. (60 cm) **USDA Hardiness Zones:** 7 to 10

A very versatile and popular herb, rosemary makes a beautiful ornamental plant, as well as great culinary seasoning with exceptionally flavorful leaves. Clip individual rosemary leaves or stem tips as needed, and use for flavoring meats, poultry and potatoes.



Spearmint

Sage

4 to 8

Height: 4 to 6 in. (10 to 15 cm)

USDA Hardiness Zones: 3 to 10

Perfect for cooking or as a garnish, Spearmint is best fresh, harvested as soon as you see it bloom. Spearmint spreads vigorously through its roots, making it difficult to maintain in the garden, so we recommend you grow it in pots. Use its flavorful leaves with vegetables and in any Summer drink, especially mojitos.




