



Costa Rican Sweet Pepper

- Plant in Sun  (at least 6 hrs of sun)
- Space 12-18" (30-46cm) apart
- Grows 18-24" (46-61cm) tall by 12-18" (30-46cm) wide
- Water in moderation; the soil must drain well.
Peppers don't tolerate saturated soil that waterlogs their roots.
Don't overfertilize.
Use mulch to prevent excessive evaporation from the soil during the dry Summer months.
For support, loosely tie the plants to stakes using rubber bands to allow for the expansion that comes with growing.
