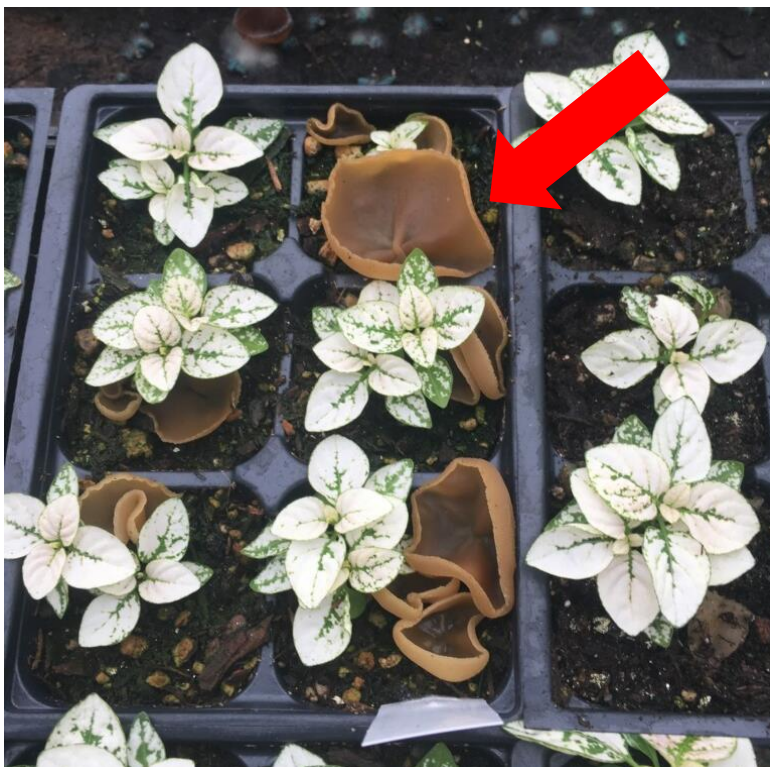


Tech Tip 2018



A fungus among us. Don't fret – nearly all mushrooms that we can see with our eyes are not pathogenic to plants. This one is called *Lepiota*. While you still shouldn't eat them, glove-up and simply pluck and toss them in the trash. These tend to be ephemeral so fungicide application is generally not recommended.



Alien or Earth? This one is the Earth bound *Peziza*. Like most other mushrooms seen in plantings, it is ephemeral and will disappear pretty quickly but removal by hand would be recommended in these tight plantings. This fungus is susceptible to triazole and carboxin fungicides so contact your extension service for guidance.
