Alert: Most Lilies are shipped frozen...

Upon arrival of frozen lilies, open the crate or the plastic bag immediately to give the bulbs fresh air and prevent build-up of Ethylene which kills buds.

Introduction

The Lilies listed in this Cut Catalog are produced and grown in The Netherlands and in New Zealand (SH).

Prior to packing, all bulbs are washed, graded and packed in special peat to ensure proper pre-cooling for shorter or longer times.



All bulbs have had various temperature treatments to shorten the forcing period or to delay planting times for year-round production.

Harvesting...

Dutch Lilies are lifted starting the last week in September until December.

Southern Hemisphere Lilies are lifted from the end of May until July.

Introduction to Hybrid Lilies

The genus *Lilium* belongs to the family Liliaceae, which is comprised of many different plants, such as Tulipa, Hyacinthus and Hemerocallis for instance.

Most produce very showy flowers. All Liliaceae flower parts (see diagram below) are typically in sixes, both petals and sepals. Some of the species, such as Allium (onions) and Asparagus, are used for food.

The genus Lilium is a large group of bulbous plants originating in various areas world-wide.

Commercial bulb growing is being done in various countries in the Northern and Southern Hemispheres.

This is an advantage for the floral industry as the two opposites complement each other for year-round production.

Lilies are used commercially for Cut Flower productions (see this catalog) and

for Potted plant production (See Catalog for Pot Lilies 2022).

Besides these applications, all Lily species can be grown in gardens to beautify the landscape (See other Lily Catalogs).

Some Helpful Hints for Growing Lilies for Cut Flowers

Where to plant:

- In ground beds in the greenhouse.
- In ground beds outside.
- In plastic crates, inside or outside. They can be started inside and moved outside.

By each group of lilies, we listed how many bulbs are suggested to plant per square yard or per crate for various sizes.

Most Lilies can be shipped weekly; see column "Suggested Plant Weeks". Some varieties do not perform well in the darker winter months even with additional lighting.

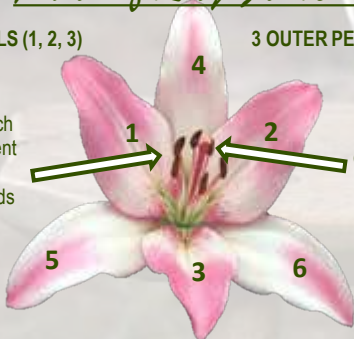

1 PISTIL, it consists of a stigma (rounded and sticky), a style, an ovary and egg cells

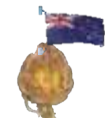

General Growing Instructions for Cut Lily Production



A.O.A. Hybrid Lilies

A.O.A. Hybrids are the result of cross-breeding Asiatic (A) and Oriental (O) lilies and again with Asiatic (A) lilies: a combination of the colorful spectrum of the Asiatics and the open-faced Orientals and again the colorful spectrum of the Asiatics.

These lilies are very popular for Cut Flower Production.

They are unique in the fact that the flowers are intense in color and much larger than regular Asiatic lilies, yet have the colorful variations which the Orientals lack. They are lightly scented.

All varieties listed in this section grow best in a normal-to-warmer environment. The number of weeks is based on a forcing temperature of 60 - 68°F. (15 - 20°C.). When grown during warmer months, forcing time will be reduced by 2 weeks.

Doubles and Pollen-Free Lilies

Through intense hybridization, the breeders have been successful in bringing Double & Pollen-Free lilies into the industry.

Double Lilies

Lilies are in the Liliaceae family and normally have 6 flower petals.

When there are more than 8 petals (through breeding) the Lilies are classified as Doubles.

Most Double Lilies have 12 petals.

Most Double Lilies are also Pollen-Free.

Double Lilies are also called Rose Lilies because of the "new" Rose look-alike appearance of the Lily flower.

Pollen-Free Lilies

These lilies have stamens (or only partly) which do not produce pollen.

Stamens are the male reproductive organ of the flower. The anther (where the pollen are produced) is either completely or nearly dried up.

The benefits of this development is that the pollen will not stain clothing (or other items) or the flowers itself. Also the longevity of the flower is extended.

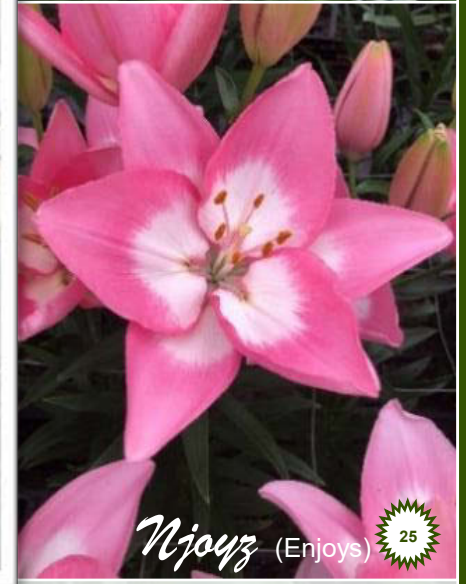

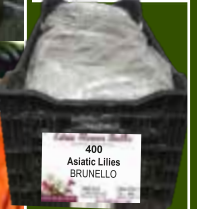

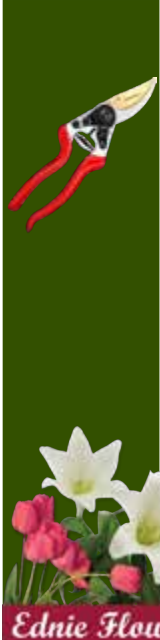

When grown during warmer months, forcing time will be reduced by 2 weeks.

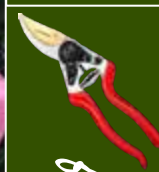

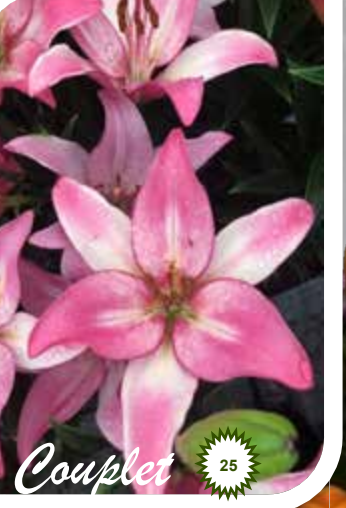

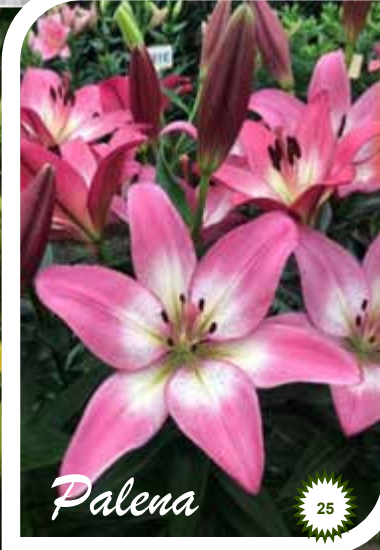

The trumpet Longiflorum shape is combined with the magnificent spectrum of the open-faced Orientals.

These lilies are very popular for Cut Flower Production. The flowers are very large and scented.

L.O. Hybrids grow best in a normal-to-warmer environment. The number of weeks is based on a forcing temperature of 60 - 68°F. (15 - 20°C).

When grown during warmer months, forcing time will be reduced by 2 weeks.

The colors are mostly reds, pinks, whites and combinations of these colors.

*Oriental*s generally take longer to force than *Asiatic*s. However, new varieties have been bred which can be forced into bloom in as little as 10 weeks.

This symbol indicates that these are fast-growing *Oriental*s.



*Oriental*s like warmer growing temperatures and do not thrive well (much) below 60 °F. (15°C.). They tolerate even warmer temperatures than *Longiflorum*s.

Oriental lilies have a tendency to be slow in making basal roots. These roots are very important for *Oriental*s, as there is a correlation between basal roots and number of flowers.

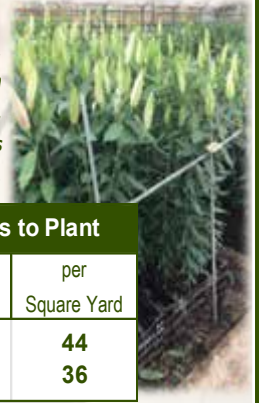

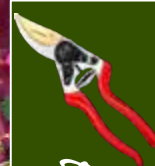

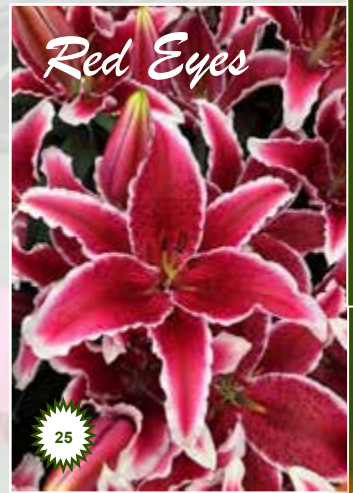

Why Southern Hemisphere (SH) Lilies?

Freshly harvested SH Lilies are ideal for winter forcing from the end of October to early April. These Lilies which are dug in late May to July are vigorous and ready to plant during the challenging growing time of the darker winter months.

Since SH Lilies are freshly dug, they perform much better than Dutch Orientals which have been in cold storage for almost a year. SH Lilies will produce optimum number of quality flowers during these months.

When switching back to planting Dutch Orientals, note that the planting dates should overlap about 2 weeks to keep up continual flower production.

Where are Southern Hemisphere Lily bulbs cultivated?

Southern Hemisphere Lilies are grown primarily in New Zealand since their growing conditions are very similar to The Netherlands and production is done under auspices of the Dutch growers with their latest "know-how". The lilies are handled and packed the same as Dutch bulbs to promote uniformity.

This symbol indicates that these are fast-growing Orientals.



Can Assimilation Lighting help?

Using freshly harvested lilies from the Southern Hemisphere can possibly eliminate the need for assimilation (or supplementing) lighting. This depends on the light hours per day, except during the shortest days when additional lighting may be necessary even for SH Lilies. Generally, the quality of light in the winter months is insufficient to grow an optimum crop of Lilies. Note: Bulbs planted in the month of November will need the most amount of additional lighting when they emerge.

Why do SH Lilies cost more than the Dutch Ones?

Part of the cost of imported flower bulbs is freight (which is increasing by the day). The distance between New Zealand and the east coast of the United States is nearly triple that from The Netherlands.

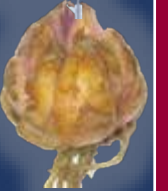

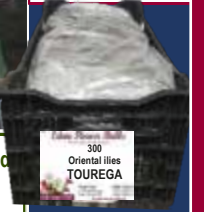

O. T. Hybrid Lilies

O. T. Hybrids are the result of cross breeding Oriental (O) lilies and Trumpet (T) lilies, a combination of the larger open-faced flowers and the large trumpet shape flowers. They are sometimes called Orien-Pet lilies. This group has a wide range of colors. Many are fragrant. Many stink. They tolerate warmer temperatures as they are generally tough, vigorous lilies. Flower petals are stronger than L.A. Hybrid lilies.

Although O.T. Hybrids have Oriental blood they generally force faster than Orientals, but take longer than L.A. Hybrids. They root easier than the Orientals and can be grown easily in same environment with L.A. Hybrids and Orientals.

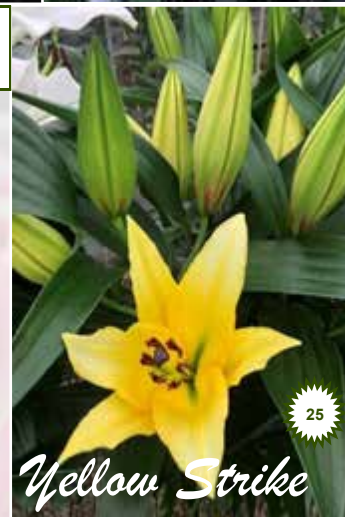

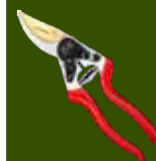
