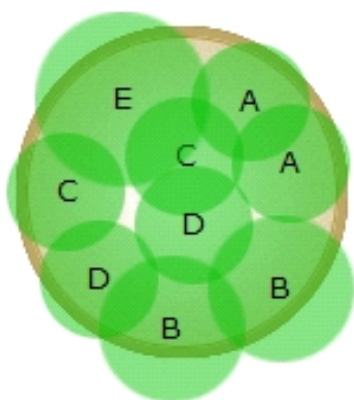

Each plant in this combination thrives in high heat while upholding its nice shape and flowering. Because these varieties love it hot, keeping the soil moist is essential along with regular feedings. You can prune back the Perilla to maintain its size and remove the dead flowers on the Geranium and Angelonia to encourage more blooming.

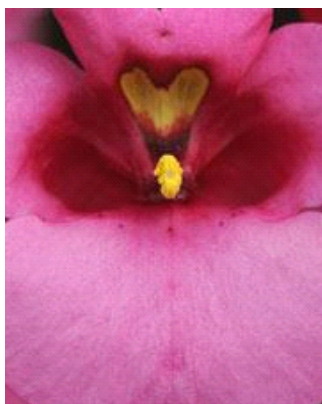

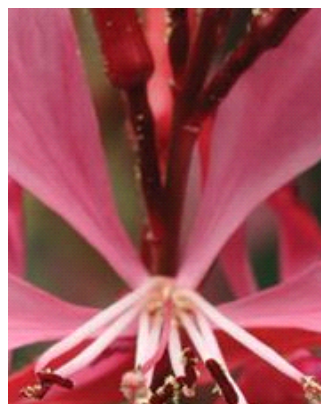

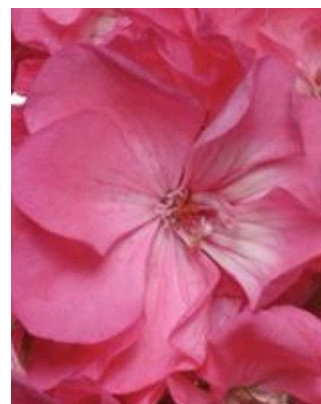
